The national Animal Care Program guides farmers to meet **rigorous standards** in animal welfare. The program is based on the Code of Practice developed in consultation with leading animal welfare, veterinary and industry experts.

The EQA® certification mark verifies that Canadian eggs are produced according to **strict food safety** and **animal welfare standards**. Our Start Clean-Stay Clean® on-farm food safety program ensures Canadian eggs are produced in line with rigorous safety and quality standards.



#### THE ENVIRONMENT

We invest in research and initiatives that help drive farm-level improvements to reduce emissions that impact air, water and soil. In fact, research shows there has been a **reduction in greenhouse gas emissions (GHG)** per tonne of eggs produced since 2012.<sup>1</sup>
